

Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak

Temporary Closure of KMUTT

As Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health issued a statement on September 3, 2020 regarding one COVID-19 patient whose residence is on Phutthabucha Road, Bangmod District, the university is concerned about this situation. To safeguard the wellbeing of students and staff as well as prevent the spread of COVID-19, by virtue of Section 24 and Section 27 of the University of King Mongkut's Technology Thonburi ACT B.E.2541, the university has thus issued the announcement with following detailed actions and steps to be taken:

During September 4-7, 2020:

- 1. Bangmod Campus will be termporarily closed.
- 2. Staff members who can remain working at the campus during this period are only those out of necessity including officers in charge of security, team members of the projects under the agreement or contract designating required duration/deadline, university infrastructure and information technology infrastructure teams and those assigned by supervisors to complete important or urgent work as the interruption would jeopardize the government work. In this regard, they must strictly comply with the surveillance measures for utmost safety of themselves and public.
- 3. Should there be any reason or need to organize any meeting or important activity for the benefit of the government, an on-line meeting is suggested. Allowance for external speakers can be reimbursed according to relevant annnouncement and criteria. In addition, the evidence of meeting attendence is required.
- 4. As for Bangmod and Bang Khun Thian Campuses, lecturers are to conduct online classes (lectures, demonstrations and all other types of multimedia) for all undergraduate and graduate courses.

5. Students and staff members who live at Ban Suanthon Condominium, Phuttabucha Road, Bangmod are requested not to physically enter the university (all areas) and study on line or work from home and take great care of themselves.

For the next 14 days from September 3, 2020 onwards

6. Any students or staff members who have a fever or experience respiratory abnormalities are requested to report the Department or immediate superiors, fill out "a Report of anticipating COVID-19 patient at KMUTT" at bit.ly/Wereport and visit health service providers according to their benefit scheme.

If there is any problem or issue arising from this announcement, Senior Vice President for Administrative Affairs and Director of Office of Building and Ground Management are tasked with deliberating and executing any action deemed appropriate.
