



Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology of Thonburi
Practices during the visit and after returning from the countries reported COVID-19 outbreak

With reference to the announcement on measures and surveillance of COVID-19 announced on Feb 14, 2020, the university has specified additional practices for the personnel who have to visit the countries reported COVID-19 outbreak as follows:

During the trip or overseas assignment, they are required to keep their supervisors informed of health status.

Upon the return from the countries with reported cases of COVID-19, those shall be ordered to work from home/residence for 14 days for monitoring purposes at the discretion of the supervisors, which will not be counted as absence or leave days.

Please strictly follow the measures stipulated in the announcement on the measures and surveillance of COVID-19
